



Title VI Notice of Non-Discrimination

Meals on Wheels for Fort Collins gives public notice that it is committed to assuring full compliance with, and is prohibited by law from violating, all civil rights provisions of federal statutes and related authorities that prohibit discrimination in programs and activities receiving federal financial assistance. These laws include but are not limited to Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964 ("Title VI"), the Civil Rights Restoration Act of 1987 (P.L. 100.259), Section 504 of the Rehabilitation Act of 1973, Title VIII of the Civil Rights Act (the "Fair Housing Act"), and the Age Discrimination Act of 1975, as amended. Meals on Wheels for Fort Collins does not, on the grounds of race, color, national origin, sex, handicap, age, marital status, religion, or familial status, discriminate against persons in the provision of its Meal Program.

Meals on Wheels for Fort Collins provides language access services at no charge to persons who have limited ability to read, write or speak English and wish to utilize services, programs or activities offered by Meals on Wheels for Fort Collins. These services include interpreters and translation of documents or portions of documents.

Any person who believes they have been discriminated against in violation of these laws has a right to file a complaint with the City of Fort Collins, with the Department of Housing and Urban Development ("HUD") or with the U.S Department of Justice.
