REFLECTIONS FROM THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR

This year has been truly remarkable. Our services have expanded impressively, now covering 27 routes and engaging over 250 volunteers. These dedicated individuals ensure that 325 clients receive fresh, warm meals five days a week. A highlight of the year, and always a personal favorite, is our ability to offer additional support through community collaboration. A notable example is the 'Blizzard boxes', which contain 8 days' worth of non-perishable meals. These are prepared for times when adverse weather prevents regular meal delivery. This initiative was made possible through a generous matching donation of \$5,000 from First Interstate Bank. complementing the contribution from the Community Foundation of Northern Colorado. The emergency food boxes were then stored at the Odell Brewing warehouse, ready for distribution as needed. I am grateful to this wonderful community willing to step up and help us with our mission.



Revenue 2022-2023


